Dear Friends

We hope you will join us on Wednesday 22 October for a visit to Charles Dickens House and Museum. This is an additional event to those initially published and replaces the RNLI visit which has been postponed. The house is Dickens only surviving home in London and gives an insight into both his life and work. He wrote both Oliver Twist and Nicholas Nickleby when living at the house, and the layout and furnishings are, as close as possible to how they were in Dicken's day.

The Charles Dickens Museum, which is next door to his house, holds the world's most important Dickens collection with over 100,000 items including manuscripts, rare editions, personal items, paintings and other visual sources.

We shall meet at 48 Doughty St. London WC1N 2LX at 11.00am and depending on group size we may be split into two subgroups as the house can only accommodate 15 people at any one time. There is a gift shop and café too if you arrive early or are waiting to go round the house. As a nineteenth century house, the stairs are mostly carpeted and the route around the house is one way. The building has a platform lift, operated on request, which accesses four of the five floors. The design and age of the building means the lift cannot access the servants' quarters and nursery in the attic however these rooms can be viewed via an interactive digital tour. Visitors exit the historic house through the museum next door.

The visit is expected to last one to 1.5 hours, after which we shall take a short walk down the road to the Lady Ottoline pub at 11a Northington St WC1N 2JF for lunch. The inclusive cost of the visit is £55 which includes both Dickens House and the Museum, and a two-course lunch with wine, beer or a soft drink. Please include your choices for main course and dessert from the attached menu, and also indicate if you are NOT over 60 years of age.

I would appreciate you letting me know if you will be joining us by <u>Tuesday 30 September</u> so that I can confirm numbers to the Museum.
