Guided Tour of the The Jewish Museum, Camden 129-131 Albert Street, London NW1 7NB 2.45 for 3pm preceded by Lunch at The Spread Eagle (Camden) 141 Albert Street, London NW1 7NB 12 noon Thursday 10th November 2022

I trust that all members are keeping in good health. It is a great pleasure as the first event in my year of office to invite members and their guests to visit the Jewish Museum in Camden at 3pm on Thursday November 10th. This will be preceded by lunch at the Spread Eagle at 12 noon. There is a Private Dining Room on the first floor. Please note that access to the Dining Room is via a narrow winding staircase.

The guided Tour will last one hour which will include an opportunity to ask questions. Following the tour there will be complimentary teas and coffees, provided the visitor feedback survey is completed! There will be the chance to explore further on your own. We will be able to have an insight into British Jewry's history from 1066. The gallery showcases the Museum's outstanding collection of Jewish ceremonial artefacts and explores the religion as a living tradition, its history culture and heritage. Highlights include a seventeenth century Venetian Synagogue Ark, magnificent Torah decorations, silver Chanukah lamps and Passover plates. The Museum's Judaica collection is one of the finest in the world and has been awarded designated status by the Museums, Libraries and Archives Council in recognition of its outstanding national importance. It was also awarded funding by the Arts Council, England. King Charles III is a Patron of the Museum.

If you are coming for lunch we will meet outside the Spread Eagle, on the corner of Albert Street and The Parkway at 12 noon. If you are only attending the Museum tour, we will meet outside the Museum at 2.45pm.

The cost of the tour of the Jewish Museum is £17.50 per person.

The cost of lunch Two courses including service is £38.80 per person. Please look at the Menu and choose from the options, and return this together with your application form.

There is a **limit of 20 people** on the tour, so applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis. If you wish to pay by cheque, please also email me so that I can put your name on the list.

Transport and Parking information

The Jewish Museum is near to Camden Town Underground Station.

Nearest Stations

Camden Town Underground Station (Northern Line) 5-minute walk

Mornington Crescent (Northern Line) 8-minute walk

Camden Road (Overground) 9-minute walk

Directions from Camden Town Underground Station

Turn left out of the station, cross the road and turn right onto Parkway A4201, turn left onto Albert Street. The Spread Eagle is right on the corner.

For those members coming directly to the Museum, this is a few doors down from the Spread Eagle.

Buses

Many buses stop near to the Museum

Parking

There are parking restrictions in the area, but the nearest public car park is at Pratt Street. There is limited metered parking on Albert Street, Parkway and Arlington Road for a two-hour duration. Blue badge holders can park in the parking bays with no time limits, as well as on yellow lines for up to three hours. The Museum is situated outside of the congestion charge zone.
