INVITATION TO LORD'S CRICKET GROUND ON 25TH JULY 2022

You and your guests are cordially invited to visit Lord's Cricket Ground, the "Grace Gates", St John's Wood Road, London NW8 8QN, on Monday 25th July at 11.15 a.m. for entrance at 11.30 a.m.

Lord's is named after its founder Thomas Lord and was opened in 1814. It has the capacity to accommodate 30,000 spectators and is recognised worldwide as the "Home of Cricket". A qualified guide will lead us through the iconic parts of the ground, including the Grade II listed Pavilion built in 1890, in which we will see the famous Long Room and the players' dressing rooms. We will continue to the J.P. Morgan Media Centre which is not only for the press but also for television and radio commentaries including "Test Match Special". Finally we will visit the Lord's Museum, home of the Ashes Urn, cricket's best-known artefact. The Museum is the oldest sporting museum in the world with many items of memorabilia.

There are a few steps into up to the entrance to the Pavilion and also to access the Dressing Rooms. In each place there is a small lift available which could hold one person or one wheelchair. Access to the second floor of the Museum is only by the stairs. There is lift access to the Media Centre.

The tour of Lord's is not only a must for cricket fans, but for everyone looking for a memorable English experience.

For those members who know the area, we will meet at the Grace Gates at 11.15 a.m. for the start of the tour at 11.30 a.m.

For those requiring guidance or travelling by train, travel St. John's Wood station (Jubilee Line) to arrive by 11.00 a.m. and I will meet you at the exit for the walk to the Grace Gates.

At the conclusion of the tour, we will walk the few yards from the Grace Gates to the Lord's Tavern for a well earned lunch and the opportunity to relax.

The cost of the tour of Lord's is £26.00 for an adult and £22 for a child aged 5-15.

The cost of lunch including wine and service is £34.65 for two courses, and £40.15 for three courses; the cost of lunch excluding wine but including service is £22.00 for two courses, and £27.50 for three courses.

I look forward to meeting you and your guests at Lord's.
